QUALIFYING METHODS

There are two methods to qualify for County elective offices. The first method is to pay a qualifying fee equivalent to 6% (4% for School Board or Non Partisan candidates) of the annual salary of the office sought:

County Commission	\$2,517.36
School Board	\$1,356.20
Clerk of the Circuit Court	\$7,686.12
Property Appraiser	\$7,686.12
Sheriff	\$9,961.20
Superintendent of Schools	\$7,686.12
Supervisor of Elections	\$7,686.12
Tax Collector	\$7,686.12

The alternative method is to collect signatures on petitions from 1% of the registered voters (as of the 2022 General Election) in DeSoto County:

Office	Signatures Needed
All County Offices	183 (1% of voters)

The last date to submit petitions for verification to the Supervisor of Elections is PRIOR to Noon, May 13, 2024. There will be a ten (10) cents per name verification fee as provided for by Florida Statute.
